RE: Changes to Data Protection Law

Assalamu Alykum

You may be aware that from May, the rules around data protection are changing. The 'General Data Protection Regulation' (GDPR) will change how we can use your personal data and keep it safe, and will also strengthen your rights over your own data.

This is to ensure sensitive or private information about yourselves and your children stays safe. GDPR is similar to the current Data Protection Act, however, there are a few differences and therefore we need to make a few changes at school in order to ensure we remain compliant.

One of these changes is that we have updated our privacy notice. Please find it enclosed.

As part of our work to comply with the GDPR, we are also re-seeking consent for using photographs/videos of your child within different aspects of the school. We have enclosed a form with this letter and would appreciate it if you filled this out and returned it to your child's form tutor by **Tuesday 5th June 2018**.
